- An Australian Overseas Diplomatic mission or Australian Educational Centre.
- Notary Public.

To Certify a photocopy of an academic transcript, the following must be written on it:

- “This is a true copy of the original document sighted by me.”
- Signature of the authorising person.
- The authorising person’s name, address, contact telephone number, profession, employing organisation and the date of verification.
- It should also contain the official seal or stamp of the organisation by which the certifying person is employed, if it has one.

Please include transcripts of other awards or qualifications and English language proficiency tests score and date of test i.e. IELTS or equivalent. A Minimum Overall Band Score in IELTS of 5.5 or more is generally required. IELTS test results are valid for 2 years only.

There is a \$US100 application fee required to be paid at the time of application. This will be deducted from you enrolment fees if your application is successful. By paying this fee, you are officially assigning IAE as your education agent and will receive all associated benefits, such as fee funding assistance, student discounts and access to a wide range of commercial services. Admission and Acceptance Procedure After assessment of qualifications and English language proficiency successful applicants will receive an official written offer of a place from the University. Students must accept their place, in writing, by the deadline specified in their letter of offer, otherwise the offer will lapse. Please note that Medicine and Dentistry programs have limited places and the University reserves the right to decline acceptances once the quotas have been filled. Unsuccessful applicants will be notified in writing if they are not accepted into an undergraduate academic program. Private students and students sponsored by home governments and other external agencies will be required to arrange for an advance payment of AUD\$6000, plus Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC). On receipt of these payments and fulfilment of any conditions of the offer, the University will send the documents necessary to apply for a student visa at the Australian Diplomatic Mission in the student's home country.
